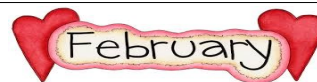
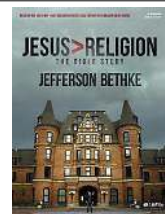

Baby bottles for the Pregnancy Support Center are due back February 11.



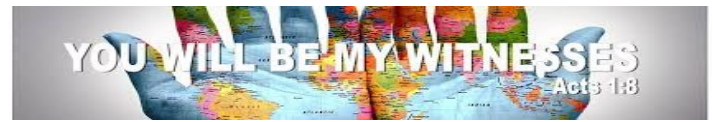

4. 395 children in foster care had Christian case managers who believe this is their mission field.
5. 42 families were trained and licensed to become foster parents.
6. Children in Therapeutic Group Homes and Treatment Foster Care could experience a wonderful summer camp.
7. 57 older teenagers were able to transition from foster care to independent living.
8. 14 developmentally disabled adults received love and care.
9. Hundreds of children experienced a Christmas they will never forget—not just because of the presents you provided for them, but because they learned the true meaning of Christmas.
10. 208 children now have "forever" homes.
11. 8 children in residential ministries (and numerous others in foster care) came to know Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior.

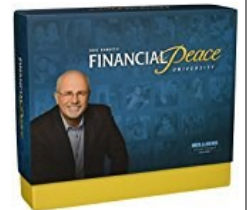
