children they can have at one time.

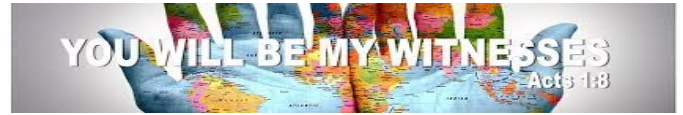
You are encouraged to register your child as soon
