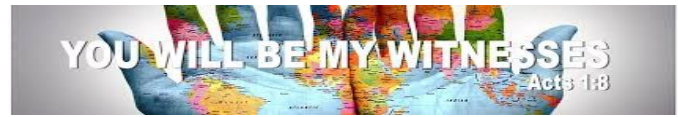
NATIONAL DAY OF PRAYER
