As we study the lives of four men and one woman who demonstrated obedience and trust in the steadfastness of our God, we hope you are encouraged. God fulfills His promises—every last one.

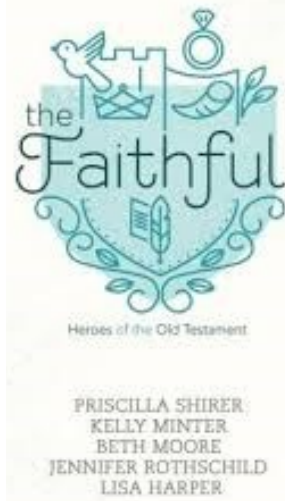
