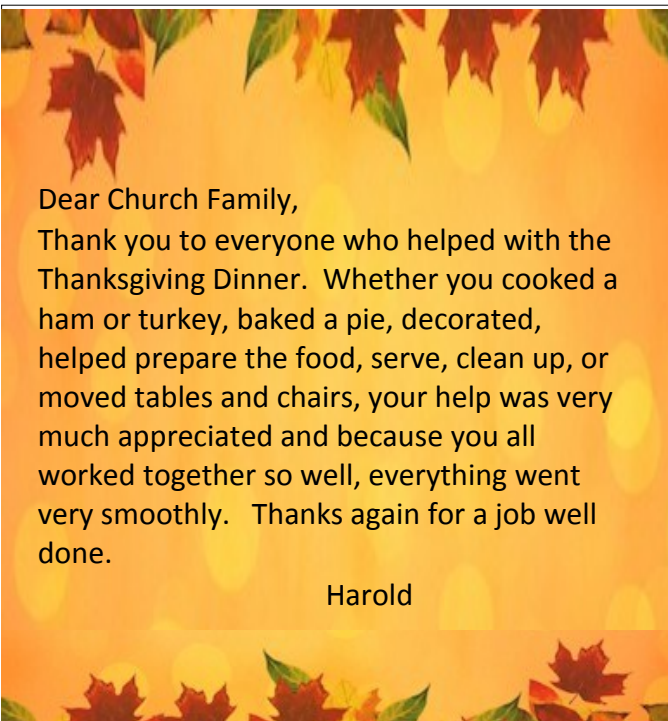


We have several shirts that we would like to put into use. If you are new and don't have a shirt, or if yours has faded, or maybe you need a new size, we have the following shirts available.

The items need to be here by December 12.

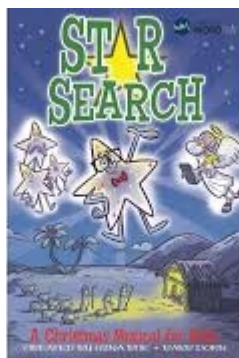
