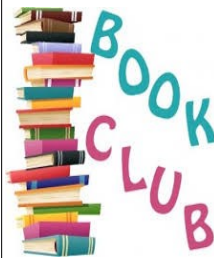
**DAMAC**

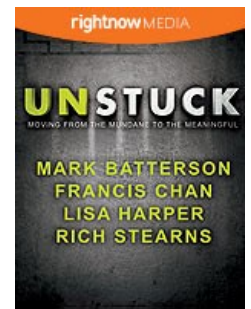
