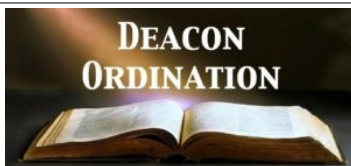

EASTER PICTURES

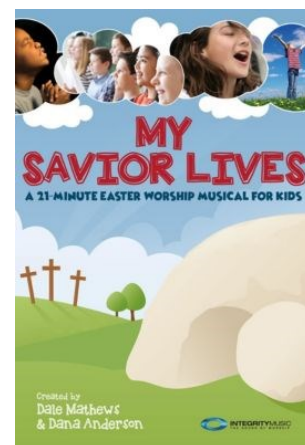
