2. We combat debilitating doubt by identifying our weaknesses.
 - The depressed are in danger of doubt.
 - The disappointed are in danger of doubt.
 - The lonely are in danger of doubt.
3. We combat debilitating doubt by making good decisions.
 - Admit your doubts and ask for help.
 - Focus on Jesus and find strength in His Word.
 - Learn to trust in the dark.
4. We combat debilitating doubt by loving all who struggle.
 - Be available
 - Be patient
 - Be prepared
