MORNING WORSHIP Distance Learning "Paul's Legacy" 2 Timothy 2:1-13

- 1. Paul wanted to pass on to Timothy a legacy of faithful <u>influence</u>. (vv. 1-2)
- Influence is automatic—intentionality is not.
- Influence is most powerful when we invest our lives in something greater than ourselves.
- Influence should naturally flow from Christian maturity.
- 2. Paul wanted to pass on to Timothy a legacy of faithful <u>endurance</u>. (vv. 3-7)
- Endure like a dedicated soldier.
- Endure like a disciplined athlete.
- Endure like a hard-working farmer.
- 3. Paul wanted to pass on to Timothy a legacy of faithful <u>allegiance</u>. (vv. 8-13)
- Allegiance to the Gospel.
- Allegiance to the Word of God.
- Allegiance to the Mission.

- EVENING WORSHIP Jeremiah: Faithful to the Mission "Crisis Shepherding" Jeremiah 23:1-40
- God provided <u>hope</u> in the midst of a spiritual <u>crisis</u> through Jeremiah's <u>faithful</u> shepherding. (23:1-5)
- Judah faced <u>destruction</u> and <u>exile</u> because of failed spiritual leadership.
- Judah received the <u>promise</u> of <u>physical</u> restoration ultimately.
- Judah received the <u>promise</u> of <u>spiritual</u> restoration ultimately.
- God provided <u>discernment</u> in the midst of a spiritual <u>crisis</u> through Jeremiah's <u>faithful</u> shepherding. (vv. 9-40)
- Jeremiah exposes the <u>disgraceful conduct</u> of the false prophets. (vv. 7-15)
- Jeremiah exposes the <u>dishonest message</u> of the false prophets. (vv. 16-32)
- Jeremiah exposes the <u>disrespectful attitude</u> of the false prophets. (vv. 33-40)
