MORNING WORSHIP Distance Learning "The Pastor's Mandate, and How You Can Help" 2 Timothy 4:1-8

- 1. A pastor must faithfully <u>preach</u> the <u>Word</u>; help him by <u>loving</u> the <u>Word</u> and by <u>living</u> it <u>out</u>. (vv. 1-4)
- I must preach the word <u>consistently</u>. (v. 2a)
- I must preach the word <u>lovingly</u>. (v. 2b)
- I must preach the word <u>correctly</u>. (vv. 3-4)
- 2. A Pastor must faithfully <u>carry out</u> his <u>ministry</u>; help him by praying for him and by following his leadership. (v. 5)
- I must keep a clear head about everything.
- I must endure hardship.
- I must do the work of an evangelist.
- 3. A pastor must faithfully <u>strive</u> to <u>finish strong</u>; help him by encouraging him and keeping him accountable. (vv. 6-8)
- I must be <u>unselfish</u>; my <u>life</u> is not my <u>own</u>. (v. 6)
- I must be <u>resilient</u>; my life was not meant to be easy. (v. 7)
- I must be <u>confident</u>; my <u>reward</u> will be <u>worth</u> it. (v. 8)

EVENING WORSHIP Jeremiah: Faithful to the Mission "Coming to terms with Exile" Jeremiah 28:1-29:32

- 1. Jeremiah's early role in the exile required <u>confrontation. (28:1-15)</u>
- Not everyone who speaks <u>for</u> the Lord speaks <u>from</u> the Lord.
- It is wise to submit to God's correction sooner rather than later.
- <u>Recognize</u> and <u>accept</u> the yoke God has for you.
- 2. Jeremiah's early role in the exile required <u>clarification</u>. (29:1-19)
- Jeremiah brought a word of clarity regarding their situation.
- Jeremiah brought a word of clarity regarding their future.
- Jeremiah brought a word of clarity regarding their perspective.
- 3. Jeremiah's early role in the exile required <u>condemnation</u>. (29:20-32)
- Don't <u>oppose</u> God's <u>plan</u> and don't <u>oppose</u> God's <u>man</u>.
- Don't <u>give up</u> on God because God hasn't <u>given up</u> on you.


