MORNING WORSHIP

Distance Learning “The Pastor’s Mandate, and How You Can Help” 2 Timothy 4:1-8

1. A pastor must faithfully preach the Word; help him by loving the Word and by living it out. (vv. 1-4)
 - I must preach the word consistently. (v. 2a)
 - I must preach the word lovingly. (v. 2b)
 - I must preach the word correctly. (vv. 3-4)
2. A Pastor must faithfully carry out his ministry; help him by praying for him and by following his leadership. (v. 5)
 - I must keep a clear head about everything.
 - I must endure hardship.
 - I must do the work of an evangelist.
3. A pastor must faithfully strive to finish strong; help him by encouraging him and keeping him accountable. (vv. 6-8)
 - I must be unselfish; my life is not my own. (v. 6)
 - I must be resilient; my life was not meant to be easy. (v. 7)
 - I must be confident; my reward will be worth it. (v. 8)

Jeremiah: Faithful to the Mission “Coming to terms with Exile” Jeremiah 28:1-29:32

1. Jeremiah’s early role in the exile required confrontation. (28:1-15)
 - Not everyone who speaks for the Lord speaks from the Lord.
 - It is wise to submit to God’s correction sooner rather than later.
 - Recognize and accept the yoke God has for you.
2. Jeremiah’s early role in the exile required clarification. (29:1-19)
 - Jeremiah brought a word of clarity regarding their situation.
 - Jeremiah brought a word of clarity regarding their future.
 - Jeremiah brought a word of clarity regarding their perspective.
3. Jeremiah’s early role in the exile required condemnation. (29:20-32)
 - Don’t oppose God’s plan and don’t oppose God’s man.
 - Don’t give up on God because God hasn’t given up on you.
