2)	I acknowledge and agree that these activities will be on a campground, on and around horses. I realize that even under well supervised conditions, there is still			
	risk involved. Horseback riding is classified as a rugged adventure recreational spot activity and that there are numerous obvious and non-obvious inherent risks			
	always present. Horses are larger, more powerful, and faster than a human. If a rider falls from a horse to ground it will generally be from a distance of 3-1/2 to 5			
	1/2 feet, and the impact may result in injury, paralysis or even death. Camp WHOA has chosen lesson horses for their calm dispositions and sound basic training			
	and follows a rigid risk reduction program. Yet no horse is a completely safe horse. Listed below are further examples of dangers: (a) The propensity of any horse			
	to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm or death to persons on or around it (b) The unpredictability of any horse's reaction to such things as sounds,			
	sudden movement, and unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals; (c) Certain hazards such as surface and subsurface conditions; (d) Collisions with other horses			
	or objects (e) The potential of a participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain			
	control over the animal or not acting within his ability.
