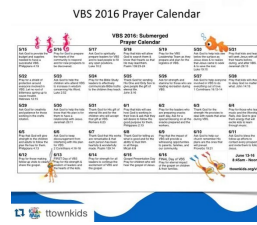

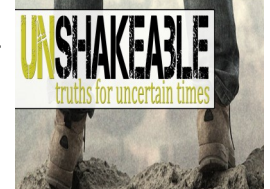

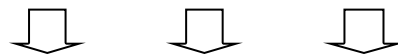
WORLDVIEW CONFERENCE
