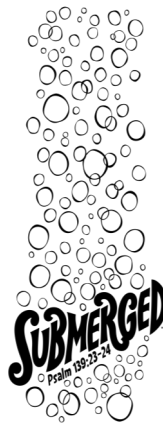
VBS

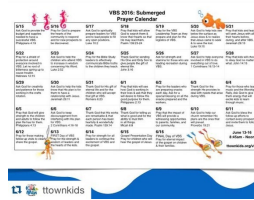

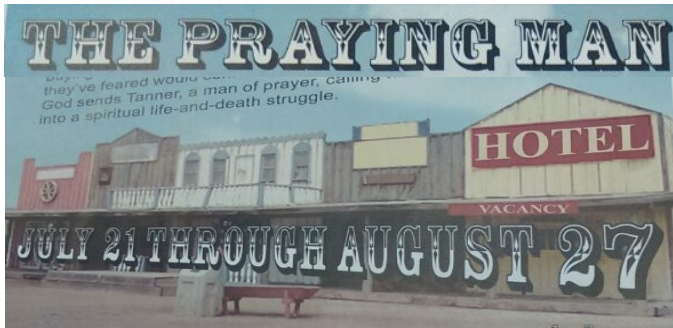
