There will be a baby shower September 11, at 4 pm in the fellowship hall for Corbin and Adele LaFon.



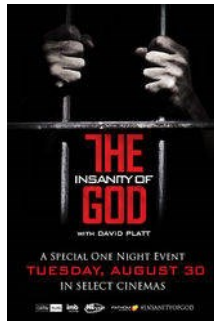
## SPECIAL BUSINESS MEETING

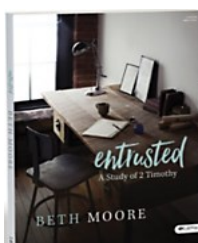
## LADIES

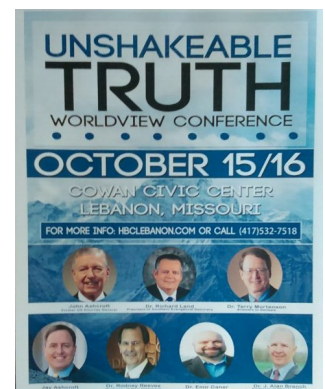
