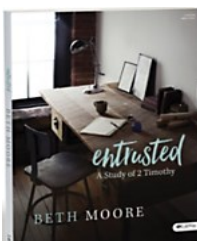


LADIES

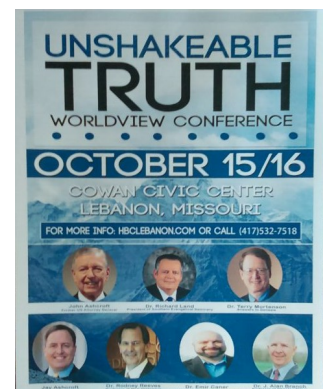
