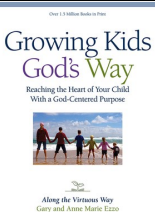

LET'S REPAINT THE FELLOWSHIP HALL

Our August business meeting authorized \$3600 to repaint our sanctuary. The cost, requiring two paint coats, was \$3400.

Our painter quoted \$2850 for repainting the fellowship hall with two coats. He has offered a \$600 reduction. That, coupled with \$200 from the sanctuary job, results in \$2050 to repaint the fellowship hall... a great deal!

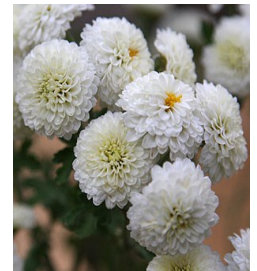
CHILD PROTECTION TRAINING

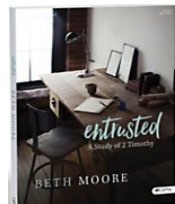

We still need two men to help with the boys in T&T. **Is it you?**

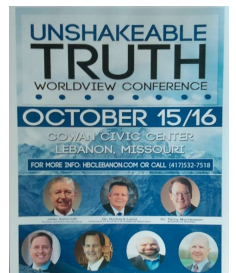
