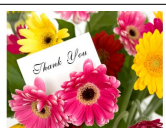

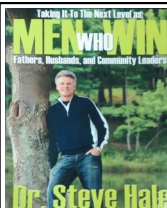

## Men Who Win Conference

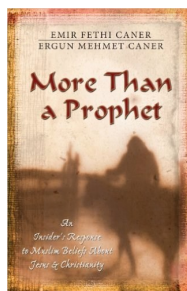
