
GriefShare begins Sunday night, April 23, at 6 pm. If you know of someone who might benefit from this class, please give us their

Please continue to pray for the church planting school. If you would like to donate toward the expenses, mark your envelope "School-Senegal".


Donations of used laptops would be appreciated for believers to communicate and to show the Jesus film.
