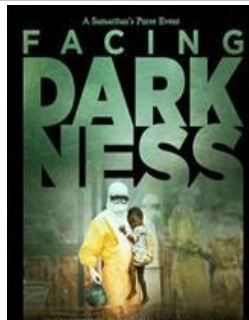

### **KIDS CAMPOUT**

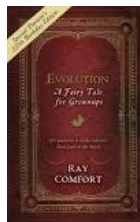
Kids PreK-5th grade will have a campout on April 21-22. Everyone will meet at the church at 5 pm April 21.
