

NEWS FROM SENEGAL

The first Church Planting School graduated 16 students. Since then 12 house churches have been planted. This makes 27 in the last two years. Two of the church planters helped other organizations start two of the house churches. This is good fruit and a witness of unity and service as the movement is working with those who want to glorify Christ and multiply disciples. The maturity of faith is evident with a lack of a competitive spirit and more of a cooperative spirit.

The second graduation just celebrated at the end of May represents encouraging multiplication. We grew from one school to two schools with a total of 17 graduates. Let us pray for the Lord to lead these church planters with boldness and anointing to establish His witness in unreached villages. The Muslim background believers are growing in boldness and zeal to reach Muslim villages.

The third class of Church Planting Schools will begin in January 2019. Please begin to pray for the Lord's provision of instructors, students and more schools as they plan for this next class. A Discovery Bible Training School for younger adults will be held in August and September. The focus is to equip the young adults to start these groups on their university campuses and villages.
