



TRAINING AT MBCH

Many of you have probably seen the article printed recently in the Houston Chroni-

cle and it has been on national news. This is coming on top of an interview by NBC involving 6 ladies now grown that were molested while attending missionary kid boarding schools in Senegal and the Philippines. Their parents were missionaries in these countries with New Tribes Missions, now Ethos 360. Three of these girls subsequently graduated from Camdenton High School.

This is extremely sobering and concerning to us as Christians. First off, we must pray for these victims, and as hard as it seems, the perpetrators, that God will change their lives. Child sexual abuse is a problem for our society not just Southern Baptists or Christians. As Christ-followers we need to be aware and act on this problem.

One in ten children are sexually abused by the age of 18. Missouri Baptist Children's Home is asking our churches to be aware of this problem and will provide training, "Stewards of Children". This training is available at no cost or a minimal charge for participant workbooks.


