There is a sign up sheet at the Welcome Center. We have approximately 90-100 workers and they will be eating in the fellowship hall.

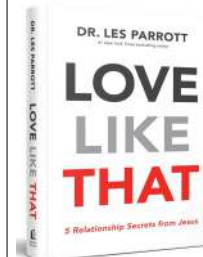

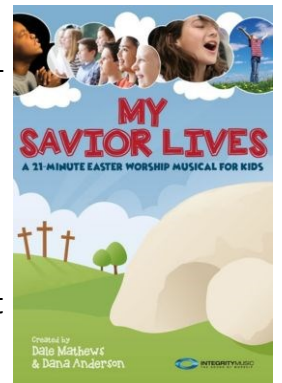
