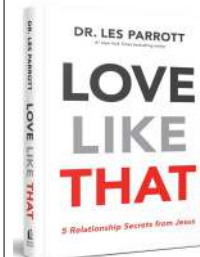


Please check your mailbox frequently. If a letter wasn't mailed to you from your Deacon, you should have one in your mailbox. If you haven't gotten one, let Linda know.
