A discipleship program for children on Wednesday nights is a high priority with our leadership, but a program needs adult workers.

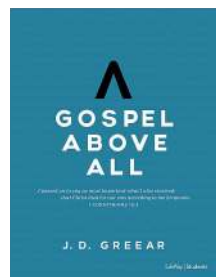
We are currently in a “laborers are few” situation. To continue with Awana, a minimum of 6 men and 4 women are still needed to staff grades K-5.
