CAMP INFO

At this time, no changes in camps have been made. Should changes need to be made, a decision will be made in proper time.

Family Camp—completed K through second grade and a parent/grandparent is required. Cost is \$35 per child, parents/grandparents are free. Date is May 28—May 30. Registration and fee is due May 15.

Youth Camp—completed 6-12 grade. Camp fee is \$60. Camp will be held from June 1-June 5. Registration and fee is due May 15.
