MORNING WORSHIP

It's Still Easter!

“A Resurrection Story”

Luke 24:1-12

1. The resurrection story reminds us that our faith is not flimsy. (vv. 1-3)
 - The accounts that verified the resurrection were not flimsy.
 - The accounts that explained away the resurrection were flimsy.
2. The resurrection story reminds us that God is at work in the midst of broken lives. (vv. 4-6A)
 - God is at work when we are afraid and confused.
 - God is at work when we are alone and discouraged.
 - God is at work when we are ashamed and defeated.
3. The resurrection story reminds us to lean on what we know when times are hard. (vv. 6B-8)
 - I must remember that God is good when times are hard.
 - I must remember that God is faithful when times are hard.
 - I must remember that God is near when times are hard.
4. The resurrection story reminds us to keep on sharing despite the doubts of others. (vv. 9-12)

CAMP INFO



At this time, no changes in camps have been made. Should changes need to be made, a decision will be made in proper time.

Family Camp—completed K through second grade and a parent/grandparent is required. Cost is \$35 per child, parents/grandparents are free. Date is May 28—May 30. Registration and fee is due May 15.

Youth Camp—completed 6-12 grade. Camp fee is \$60. Camp will be held from June 1- June 5. Registration and fee is due May 15.

Children's Camp—completed 3-6 grade. Camp fee is \$50. Camp will be held June 8-12. Registration and fee due May 29.

Camp Whoa age 9-12 is June 14-17. Camp Whoa age 13-18 is June 14-June 20. Cost is \$50. Registration and fee is due May 22.

It is possible for a child to attend more than one camp. Hillcrest pays **half of one camp** for children and youth affiliated with our church. If you cannot afford to pay your half of the fee, please let someone in the office know. We have scholarships available.
