“The Bigger Story”
Jeremiah 24:1-25:38

1. God starts solving our problems before we fully understand them. (24:1-10)
 - Judah was facing corporate judgment, but God was dealing with people individually.
 - Often the worst things that happen to us turn out to be blessings in disguise.
2. God uses world events and wicked kings to bring about His purpose. (25:1-17)

Shoebox items for May are hygiene items: deodorant, soap, comb, brush, washcloth, etc.

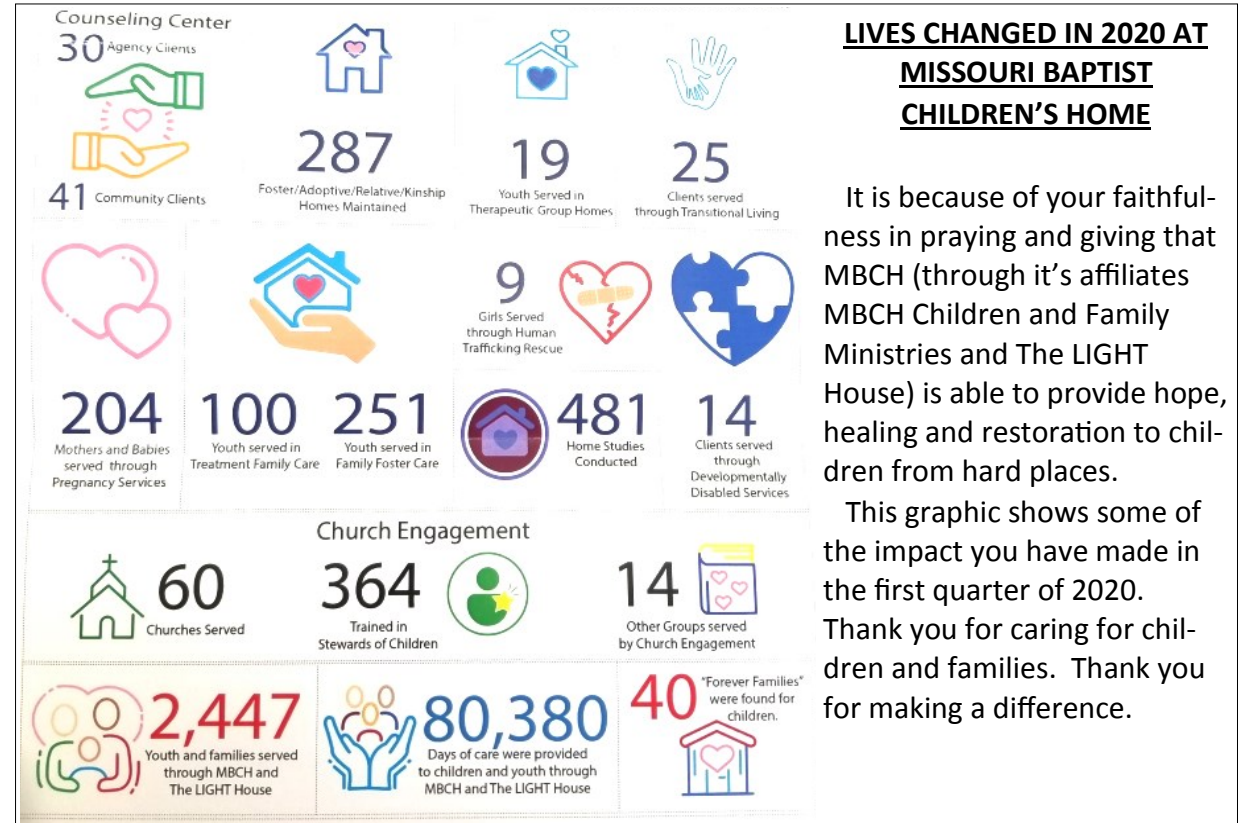
We will not be passing offering plates for awhile, so boxes have been placed in the foyer for your use. They are located on each post below the bulletin holders.
