If your group uses a quarterly and you do not have one, they are available in the meeting area of your class.

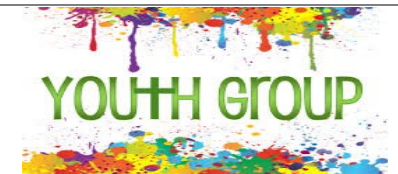
CHILDREN'S CHURCH
