Distance Learning "Required Reading" 2 Timothy 3:10-17

- 1. Because of the Word of God I can <u>follow</u> the right <u>example</u>. (vv. 10-14)
- The Bible is the standard for private instruction. (vv. 10-11)
- The Bible is the standard for proper perspective. (v. 12)
- The Bible is the standard for personal inspection. (vv. 13-14)

EVENING WORSHIP Jeremiah: Faithful to the Mission "The Uncompromising Prophet"

Jeremiah 26:1-27:22

- 1. Jeremiah's uncompromising <u>message</u> almost <u>ended</u> his <u>life</u>. (26:1-11)
- Jeremiah's job wasn't to <u>smooth</u> things <u>over</u>, it was to <u>straighten</u> things <u>out</u>!
- Jeremiah said <u>exactly</u> what God wanted him to say and the people still heard something <u>completely</u> different.
- 2. Jeremiah's uncompromising <u>testimony</u> probably <u>saved</u> his <u>life</u>. (26:12-24)
- Jeremiah didn't waver one bit in this testimony. (vv. 12-15) (Micah 3:11)
- Jeremiah's experience was very much like the apostles in the early church. (Acts 4:13, 19-20)
- Jeremiah's experience was similar, yet different from Jesus' (Psm. 27:1, 10)
- 3. Jeremiah's uncompromising <u>consistency</u> certainly <u>distinguished</u> his <u>life</u>. (27:1-22)
- Jeremiah's consistency stood in stark contrast to the leader's strategy. (Matt. 11:28-30)
- Jeremiah's consistency stood in stark contrast to the false prophecy. (2 Chron. 36:7; Ezra 1:7; 7:19)
